From old faded scrap of paper with names written down by FROM MEMORY years later and finally restored in 1973. Full passengers above 8 listed in this order: Catherine, Alex, Mary & Margaret on the HECTOR From Grennock & lock Broom to Pictou

1843 • Ketch Harbour Halifax, Nova Scotia, Canada

His will was dated 6 Oct. 1834 at which time there was no mention of his wife as a survivor perhaps he trusted sons would take care of her. Court of Probate records were dated 13 Feb. 1844.

The following found in the Acadian Recorder for November 22, 1856 (microfilm at N.S. Archives) “At Ketch Harbour, on 15 inst., Mary, relic of the late John Martin, aged 98 years. May she rest in peace.”
